

Last weekend it was announced that we have entered into the Prayer Phase of our capital stewardship campaign. It is heartening to witness our parish family join together to become a part of and to support our *A Walk in Faith* campaign.

During the Prayer Phase of the campaign, each of us is challenged to seek and follow God's will in meeting the needs of our church. Each of us is asked to personally reflect on the theme "Not Equal Gifts, but Equal Sacrifice." This is a reflective phase of the campaign when each of us as individual parishioners is asked to reflect on the blessings we have received and be thoughtful as we prayerfully discern how we will participate in this capital stewardship campaign.

Each of us will be asked to consider a 1-year sacrificial commitment *over and above* our annual offertory support. No one will be pressured or told how much to give. Each of us is asked to give according to his/her blessings. If someone wishes to extend the 1-year timeframe in order to make a sacrificial pledge, simply indicate your intention on the commitment card.

Please pray for our campaign leaders as they work together to lead this campaign that will strengthen our parish and enrich the lives of each of us, as well as future generations that will be blessed by their leadership and our efforts as a faith community.
